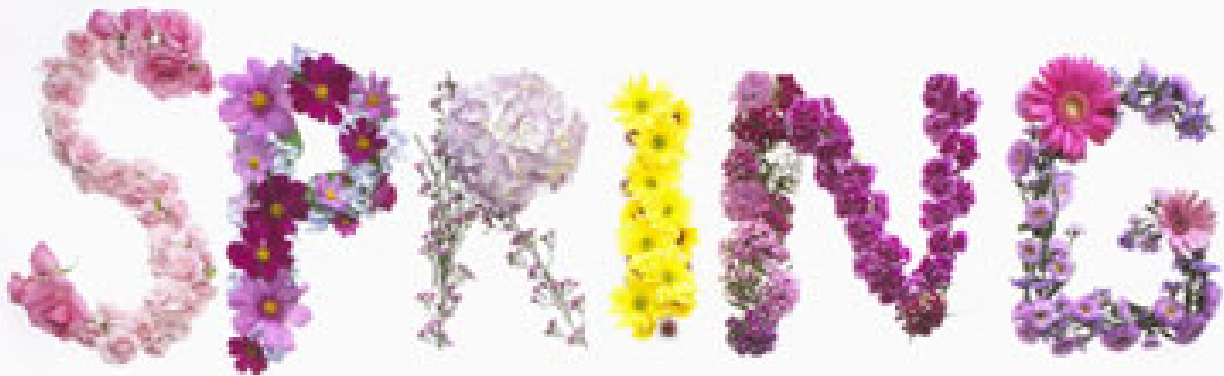

Registration for residents of Palm Springs will begin Monday, April 3rd. Non-Resident registration will begin Monday, May 1st. Both camps will start on Monday, June 5th. The cost of the camp is \$125 per week with a one-time registration fee of \$25 which includes 5 camp T-shirts. Also included



in the camp fees is breakfast and lunch (provided through Palm Beach County), field trips, and all supplies used at camp. There will be a \$10 discount for all weeks paid in full by May 20th.
