



# Transferring eBooks...

## TO AN EREADER!

eBooks downloaded from the Palm Springs Library's Digital Media Collection in either EPUB or PDF format can be transferred to many popular eReader devices for reading enjoyment on the go! Compatible eReaders include the Barnes & Noble Nook™, Kobo™ eReader, various Sony® Readers, the Pandigital® Novel, and the Literati™ Reader. 
Before you can download EPUB or PDF eBooks to your personal computer, you must install Adobe® Digital Editions™, available free from the Digital Media Collection website. Once installed the software must be activated with an Adobe ID, which authorizes you to download and read eBooks. Any eReader device that you wish to transfer eBooks to must also be activated. See the help links at the Digital Media Collection website if you need help.

You can find, check out, and download EPUB or PDF eBooks from the Library's Digital Media Collection. See the help links at the Digital Media Collection website, or view the handout "How to Download eBooks" if you need help. Once you have successfully downloaded an eBook title, you can use the Adobe Digital Editions software to transfer it to your compatible eReader device.

With Adobe Digital Editions running, plug in your compatible eReader device. The device will show up as an icon in the bottom of the left pane.



If necessary, click on the library view icon in the upper left corner of the Adobe Digital Editions window. Any books you've downloaded should become visible in the right pane.

To transfer a book to your device, simply drag the book cover image from the right pane over to the device icon on the left. The transfer will only take a few seconds. Once it is complete you may disconnect your eReader from your computer.
