

Census 2010 – We All Count

Since 1790, every ten years the United States Census Bureau has conducted a population count of everyone in the country. All U.S. residents must be counted, citizens and non-citizens, all races and ethnic groups. The results of the count determine the amount of government funding allocated to local communities. Hence, it is important that the Village of Palm Springs “Be Counted in 2010” to ensure that we receive funding for critical community services. In March 2010 Census Questionnaires will arrive to all households via U.S. Mail. Responses to the questionnaire should be representative of a household as it is on “Census Day” April 1st 2010. These questionnaires consist of 10 questions and are required by law to be **completely confidential.** **No one should be concerned about repercussions from completing the questionnaire. Be counted - The Village’s Community Services and Programs need you.**
